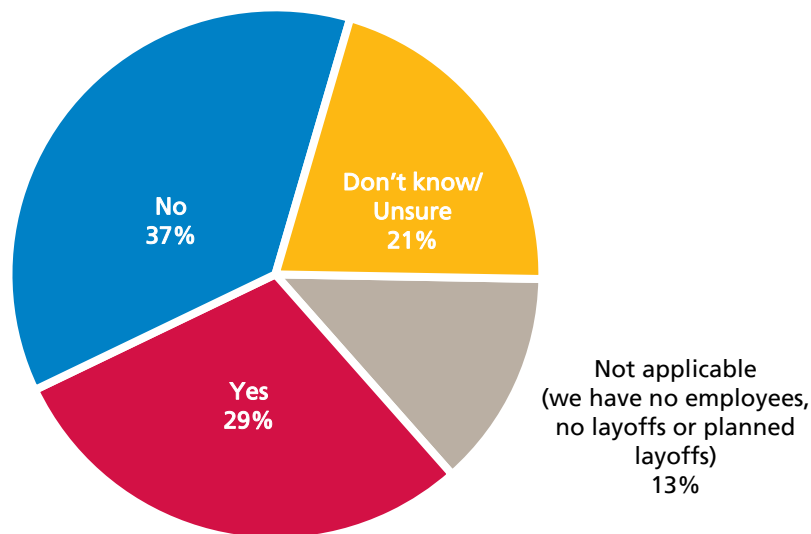
Your Business and COVID-19 – Survey #4

Preliminary Results as of April 5, 2020

Methodology

- Online survey started April 3, 2020.
- So far, it has received 8,892 responses from small business across Canada.
- For comparison purposes, a probability sample with the same number of respondents would have a margin of error of +/- 1.0%, 19 times out of 20.
- Note: the survey is still active and the following results are preliminary.

Will the Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy (CEWS) help your business avoid layoffs or cause you to recall employees that were already laid off?

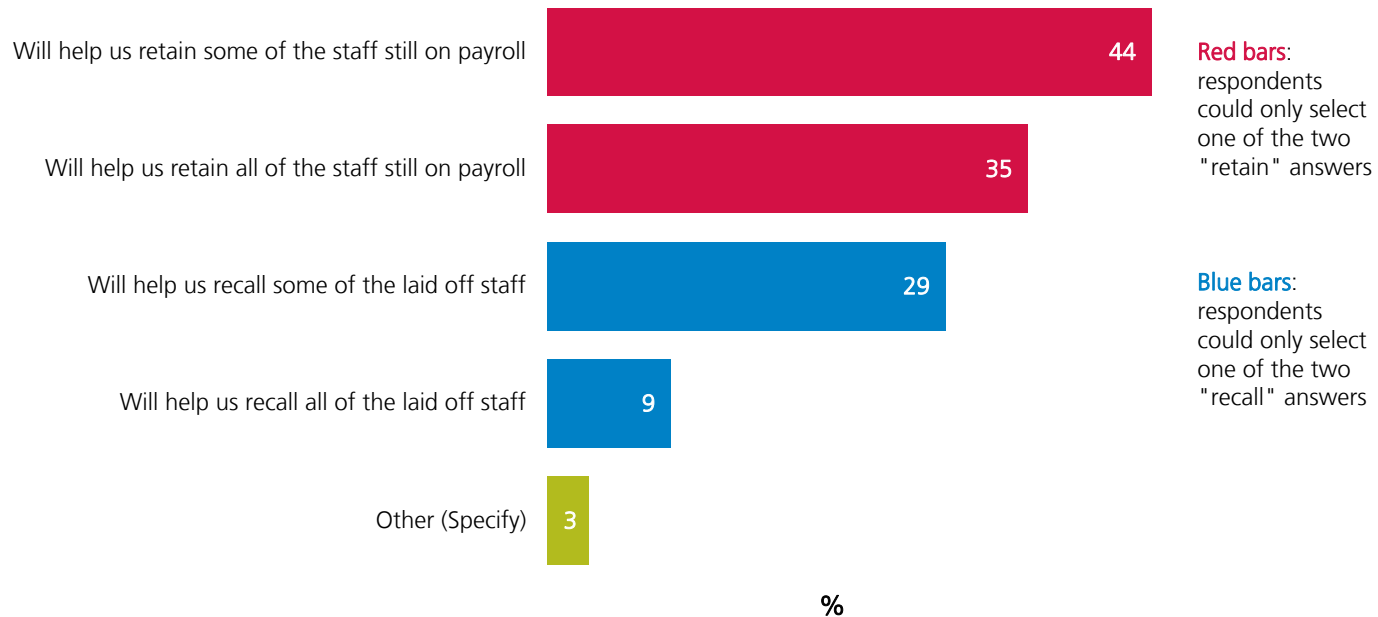

How will the Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy (CEWS) help your business?

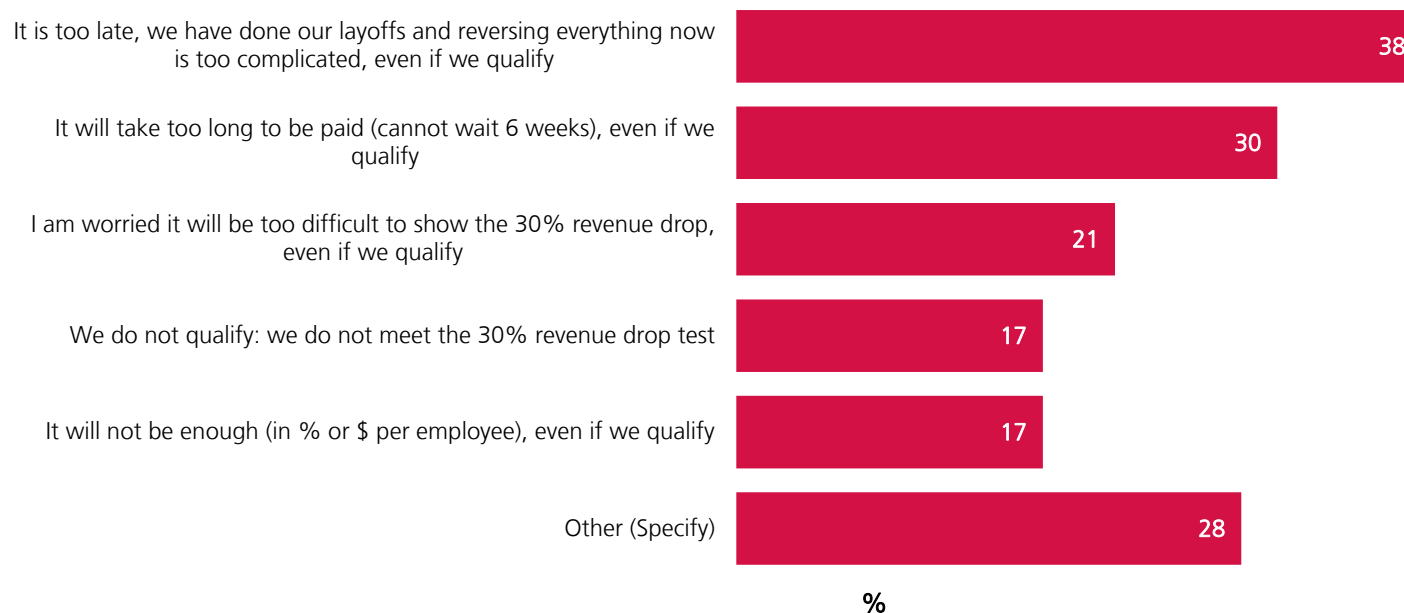

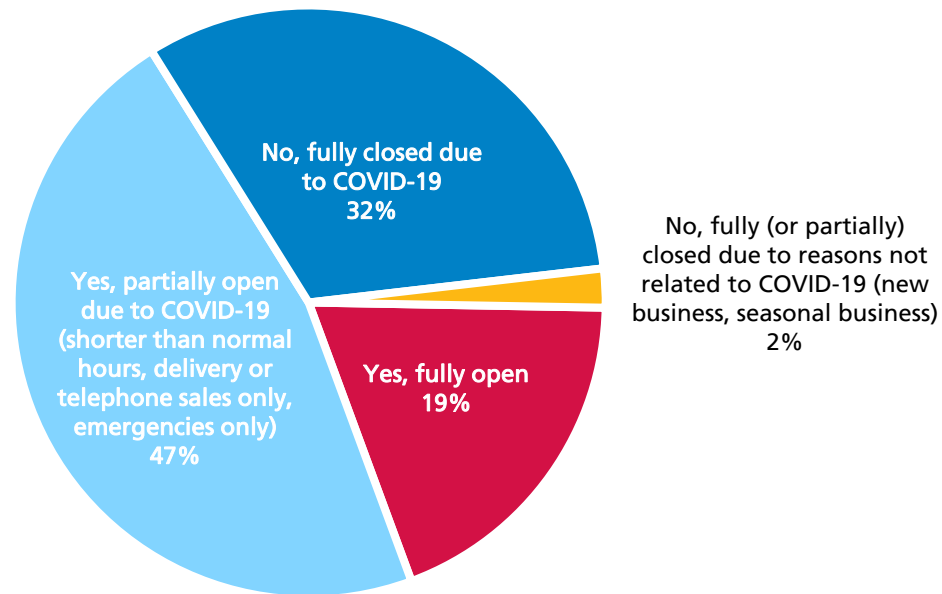
