Methodology

Flash survey: Impact of Work Stoppages

Type: A flash, controlled-access online CFIB survey.

Active dates: November 13- December 4, 2024.

Final results: Based on responses from 2382 CFIB members who are owners of Canadian independent businesses, from all sectors and regions of the country.

For comparison purposes, a probability samples with the same number of respondents would have a margin of error of +/-2.01%, 19 times out of 20.

Summary

On Canada Post potential strike:

*Nearly 80% of businesses across key sectors **rely** on Canada Post services for business continuity.

[•]75% of businesses anticipate **negative impact** from a Canada Post strike, with high concern across multiple key sectors including wholesale, construction, manufacturing, and agriculture.


Delayed payments/invoices and higher delivery costs: top impacts of a Canada post strike. Some (14%) are concerned about the holiday earnings.

Nearly 80% of businesses across key sectors rely on Canada Post services for business continuity








75% of businesses anticipate a negative impact from a Canada Post strike, with high concern across multiple key sectors including wholesale, construction, manufacturing, and agriculture.
