Urging Manitoba WCB to stop overcharging employers!

As a Manitoba business owner, I recognize the importance of every WCB being fiscally sustainable in the long-term. However, this **does not mean the Board should be overly cautious or hold onto employers' money, when it should be fully rebated.**

Currently, the WCB's funding policy sets the Board's targeted funding position at 130% (assets in excess of liabilities). In 2015, the <u>WCB was \$173 million overfunded</u>, resulting in a funding position of 143%.

<u>The Manitoba WCB does not have a rebate policy</u> that requires surplus funds (above 130%) to be rebated back to employers. The Boards in Saskatchewan and Alberta currently have rebate policies, which resulted in surplus rebates in 2016 of \$281.5 million and \$467 million respectively.

It's time to fix WCB's funding policy by:

- > Changing the targeted funding ratio from 130% to 100-110%;
- > Implementing a rebate policy that rebates surplus monies when WCB's funded status rises above the targeted ratio; and
- > Rebating the surplus in the year it is realized, like Alberta.
