


Small businesses are important to Canada's future

Ranking of selected groups* by level of respect 2011-2019






I think starting and operating a small business is easy (level of agreement in %)






Do you agree with the following statements (% of responses):





Small businesses are vital to Canadian communities


Small businesses are vital to my community (level of agreement in %)


How do small businesses contribute to your community? (% of responses)






Canadians are interested in entrepreneurship, but face obstacles

About the survey

These are the findings of a survey conducted by the CFIB in partnership with Angus Reid Global from September 11 to September 13, 2019 with a representative sample of 1,510 online Canadians who are members of the Angus Reid Forum. The survey was conducted in English and French.

The precision of Angus Reid Forum online polls is measured using a credibility interval. In this case, the poll is accurate to within +/- 1.8 percentage points, 19 times out of 20, had all Canadians been polled. All sample surveys and polls may be subject to other sources of error, including, but not limited to coverage error, and measurement error.
