Overview

Every Friday during the COVID-19 pandemic, *CFIB* is sending a survey to understand how businesses are being impacted, what support will be most useful to them, and what solutions may be available in the short- to medium-term. Surveys we have done so far:

This policy briefing will highlight more detailed results from our latest survey on the current state of Canadian small businesses (10th weekly COVID-19 survey started May 15, some results to be shared publicly this week).

Methodology

Orline survey (Your Business and COVID-19 – Survey Number Ten) started May 15.

So far, it has received 6,379 responses from small business across Canada.

For comparison purposes, a probability sample with the same number of respondents would have a margin of error of +/-1.2%, 19 times out of 20.

Note on the next pages: The percentage of responses in charts may not always add up to 100%, due to rounding or multiple choice responses. There are instances in in this briefing that we do not report on certain provinces and sectors, as the sample size is less than 40 respondents.



As of today, is your business still open? (% response)





As of today, is your business still open? (% response)







For those partially open or fully closed – What is preventing your business from fully reopening? (Select all that apply, % response)



For those with staffing issues – Which of the following are actually challenging right now for your business? (Select all that apply, % response)



Reasons for difficulty getting the work hours needed from, recalling, or recruiting staff (Select all that apply, % response)














"The expansion of CEWS to June, July and August 2020 will help my business", by sector (% response)


"Reducing the CEWS requirement to demonstrate a 30% revenue drop would help my business", by sector (% response)










"My business will apply for the newly available financial help from the federal regional economic development agencies" (% response)




Which of the following rent/mortgage situation(s) normally applies to your business? (% response)


















